

**NOTICE OF VACANCY ON
PLACER COUNTY WATER AGENCY
BOARD OF DIRECTORS
DISTRICT 1**

Notice that the Placer County Water Agency (“Agency”) has a vacancy on its Board of Directors (“Board”) for District 1 is hereby given. In accordance with state law, the Board will fill the vacancy by appointment during its May 11, 2026, 12:30 p.m., meeting at Placer County Water Agency, 144 Ferguson Road, Auburn, California.

Appointee Qualifications and Responsibilities

The appointee must be a U.S. citizen, 18 years of age, and a registered voter residing in District 1 of the Agency. As a member of the Board, the appointee’s responsibilities will include attending Board meetings, establishing assessments, rates and charges, and making decisions about the Agency’s policies related to water and energy. The appointee will serve the balance of the unexpired term of the vacant office on the Board, until noon, December 4, 2026.

Notification of Interest

The Board requests eligible candidates interested in filling the vacancy to notify the Agency’s Clerk to the Board in writing of their name, residential address, telephone number, affirmation of status as a registered voter and resident of District 1, qualifications, and responses to the following supplemental questions:

1. Why are you interested in serving on the Board, and what is your understanding of PCWA’s mission and role within the County?
2. How do you distinguish between the roles of the Board versus the roles of staff and management?
3. Describe a time when you had to make a difficult or unpopular decision. What was your approach and what did you learn from it?
4. What experience do you have interacting with community members, stakeholders, or interest groups?
5. How would you quickly become informed about current Agency matters so that you can effectively support the Agency’s governance?
6. How do you view the dual responsibility of being elected by a specific district while serving the interests of all Placer County constituents, and how would you balance those obligations as a Board member?

Submissions must be received by Lori Young, Clerk to the Board, Placer County Water Agency, no later than 5:00 p.m., Tuesday, May 5, 2026. Postmarks will not be accepted; materials must be physically received by the deadline. Submissions may be made via any one of the following methods so long as they are received by the above deadline:
